4. That the audited financial statements, prepared by Loewen Kruse Chartered Accountants for the fiscal year 2021, be approved as presented.
5. That we appoint Loewen Kruse Chartered Accountants as the accounting firm to perform an audit of the financial records and prepare the financial statements for the year 2022.
6. That the BCMB bylaws be approved as presented.
7. That the British Columbia Conference of Mennonite Brethren Churches release Heritage Mountain Community Church from membership.
8. That the BC Conference of Mennonite Brethren Churches release Point Grey Inter-Mennonite Fellowship from membership.
